


# Easy As 1, 2, 3

### 1. Expert Advice from our Sales Team:

Our knowledgeable sales personnel will provide guidance and support throughout the process of processing your used carbide inserts and round tools.

2. **Material Specifications:** We accept carbide inserts and round tools for purchase. However, please note that we do not accept ceramic inserts or HSS products.

3. **Competitive Pricing:** We currently offer an attractive price of \$20.00\* per kilogram, including GST. Please be aware that market pricing trends may cause fluctuations in the future.

4. **Minimum Purchase:** To streamline the process, we require a minimum transaction of 20 kilograms.

5. **Convenient Mixing:** You can mix both carbide inserts and round tools in the same container, making it easy for you to gather and package your recycling.

6. **Hassle-Free Packaging:** Our sales personnel will ensure a smooth experience by delivering or arranging the delivery of Sutton Tools' recycling plastic boxes, which you can use for packing.

7. **Secure Packaging:** For the safety of your items during transit, please fill the boxes provided and securely fasten the lids using two cable ties. This step is crucial to prevent any damage during transportation.

### 8. Shipping Instructions:

At your expense, send the packed boxes to our Thomastown facility, addressing them to

Carbide Recycling Program, 378 Settlement Road Thomastown 3074. We recommend using a reliable shipping method to ensure safe delivery.

9. **Efficient Check weighing:** Upon receiving your package, Sutton Tools will promptly check the weight and notify all concerned of the next steps via email.

10. **Credit Authorisation:** Sutton Tools will authorise a credit to your account based on the weight of your shipment, multiplied by the agreed price per kilogram, plus GST.

11. **Credited Amount:** You will see the credited amount reflected on your next invoice, providing you with a tangible benefit for recycling your used carbide inserts and round tools.

12. **Freight Costs:** If you choose to have our salesperson pick up the carbide and arrange the shipment to Thomastown, please note that the freight costs will be deducted from the total amount credited to your account.

13. **Efficient Storage:** Once the carbide reaches our facility, it will be stored in its original box, prominently labelled with your name and weight, ensuring easy identification and organisation.

14. **Annual Wholesale Sale:** Periodically, usually 1-2 times per year, we will combine the purchased carbide into a single shipment and sell it to our trusted partner, promoting sustainable practices in the industry.
